E. New Business

• Executive Director Martin Russell requested the Board approve Port Resolution #2014-07. This resolution authorizes Mr. Russell to sign into agreements with Henny Penny Corporation in Preble County. Henny Penny manufactures equipment used to cook food in restaurants and is undergoing an expansion phase. The deal would be very similar in structure to other sales tax exemption deals which the Port has replicated. Mr. Russell shared with the Board a letter of support from the Preble County Commissioners. He said that a letter of approval is required prior to each project in Preble County pursuant to the cooperative agreement. This shows a continuing and mutually beneficial partnership between the two groups.

• Ms. Hreben asked how the fee structures would work, and Mr. Russell responded that the fees would be roughly \$50,000-\$60,000 total. This will be split between the Warren County Port Authority and Preble County. After legal fees, Mr. Russell expects the Port to realize roughly \$20,000 in fees. Mr. Bolton made a motion, seconded by Ms. Reindl-Johnson, to approve Port Resolution #2014-07 as presented. The motion passed using a roll call vote of all present Board members.
